Things are changing within the IAA.

On April 21, 2015, we achieved our first success when the Board approved the establishment of a full time Reunion Committee. This will be a major improvement over trying to conduct business every two years at the reunion business meeting and having no volunteers. Congratulations and thank you to the committee; Babs Manning Floto, Patti Paine Johnson, John O'Brien, Dave Gibson, Edith Gordon, Mary Anderson Baker, Kathleen Ohrt Kennedy, Judi Beard Castro, and Larry Jerden. They will begin research on venues for the 2018 IAA reunion, improving events at the reunions, possible IAA cruises, and assistance with regional mini-reunions.

I recently started an IAA Discussion and Information Group on Facebook. The general idea is to identify problems and fix them. We are currently 154 members and counting. I know there are privacy concerns about Facebook but Facebook is no less secure than anything else on the Internet if you select the correct privacy and notification settings. We have tried several other forums that have proven to be more difficult and less secure. I have already conducted several practice elections/surveys with the help of 47 online volunteers. Please understand that this system will also allow mail-in and proxy voting but it will be much easier and less expensive if everyone is online. **Only an email address is needed** to vote and receive information online.

Other issues include defining membership, issues pertaining to dues, and re-writing the bylaws.

I would like to invite everyone to join us on Facebook. If you are on Facebook and do not have access to the discussion group mentioned above, simply send me a Friend Request. You may also send me your email address, preferably the one you have on file with Joe Boling. **The IAA Discussion and Information group is private** (actually secret) which supposedly means you cannot even see it unless I, or an administrator, allows you to join the group.
